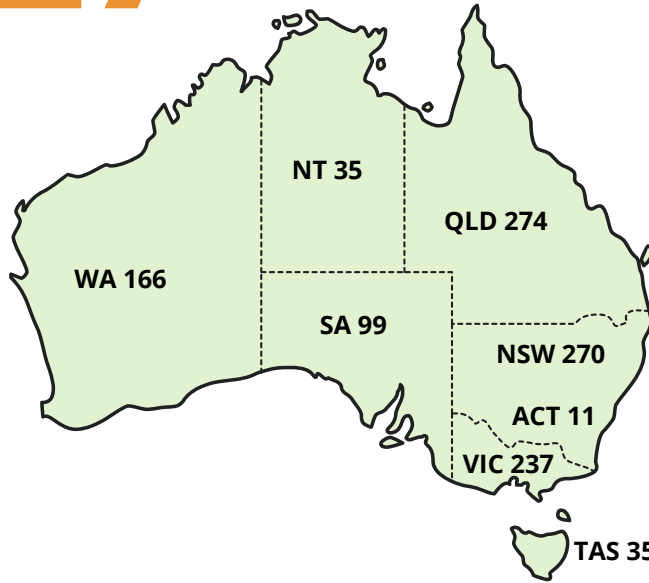

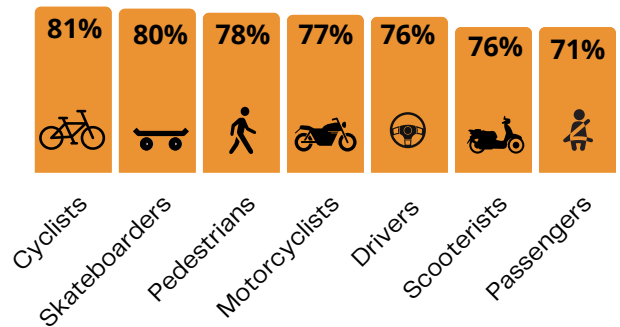

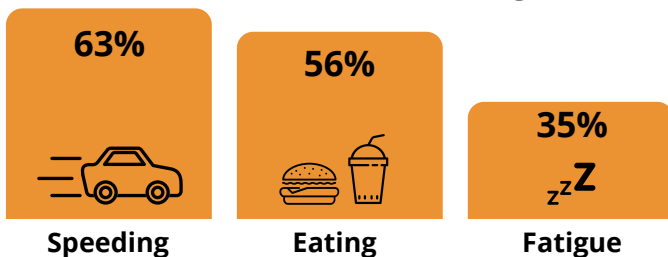
The top 2 reasons road users gave for breaking a road rule was:

- Simply not being focused on the road

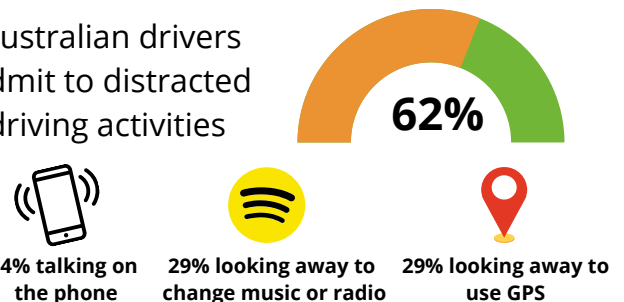
Worst offenders for breaking road laws:
