Fatality Free Friday is a national awareness campaign designed to raise road safety awareness in our community. Since its inception in 2007 the Fatality Free Friday campaign has grown and is now recognised as Australia's largest national community based road safety program.

The campaign is more than just a single day. Whilst our target is to have a

fatality free Friday on the 27th May 2022, ultimately we are aiming for a longer term community change.

The Australian Road Safety Foundation (ARSF) will launch this year's campaign on April 29th and we encourage all road users to take the pledge to Choose Road Safety this May.
