





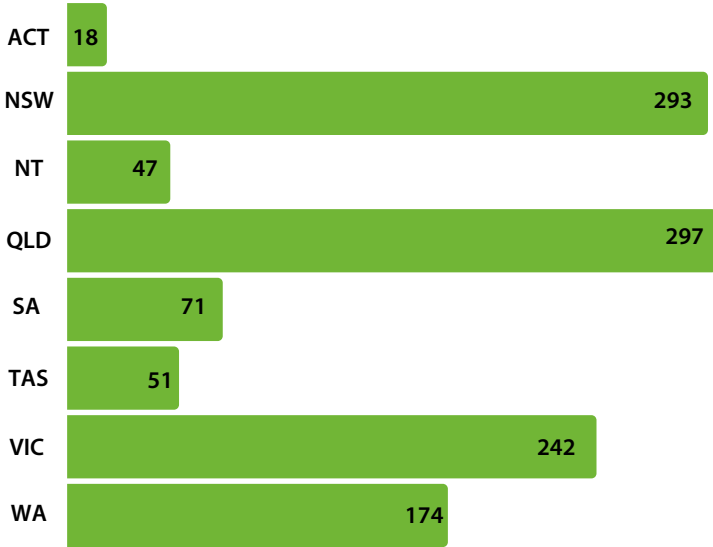


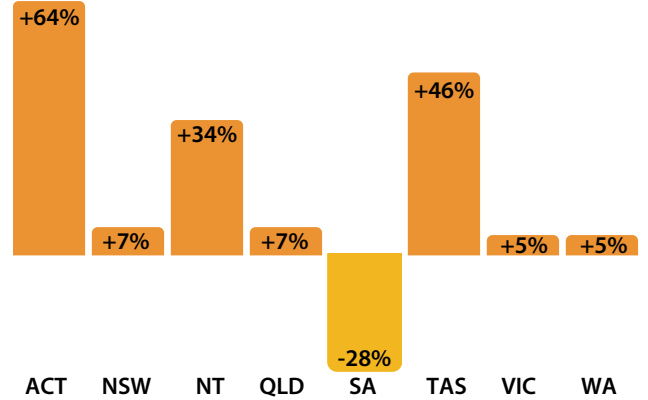

2022 Road Toll



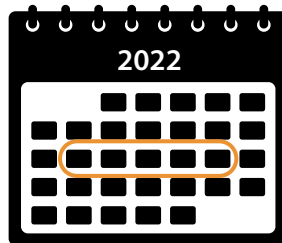
Change on previous year



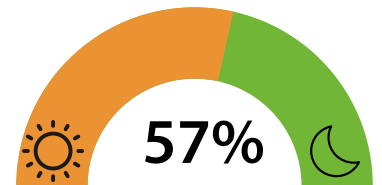
Almost **2 in 3** deaths occurred in rural or remote areas



Almost **3 in 4** deaths were male



Almost **60%** of fatalities occurred on a weekday



57% of fatalities occurred during the day



101 school aged lives were lost
