There was a total of **92** road deaths during the month of June 2023. The current figure is **2.4%** higher than the average for June over the previous five years.

Compared to 1 January - 30 June 2022, South Australia has shown the greatest increase in road deaths of **60.5%**, followed by Victoria with an increase of **28.6%**.

Cyclist deaths have increased by **53.3%** from the same period in 2022.

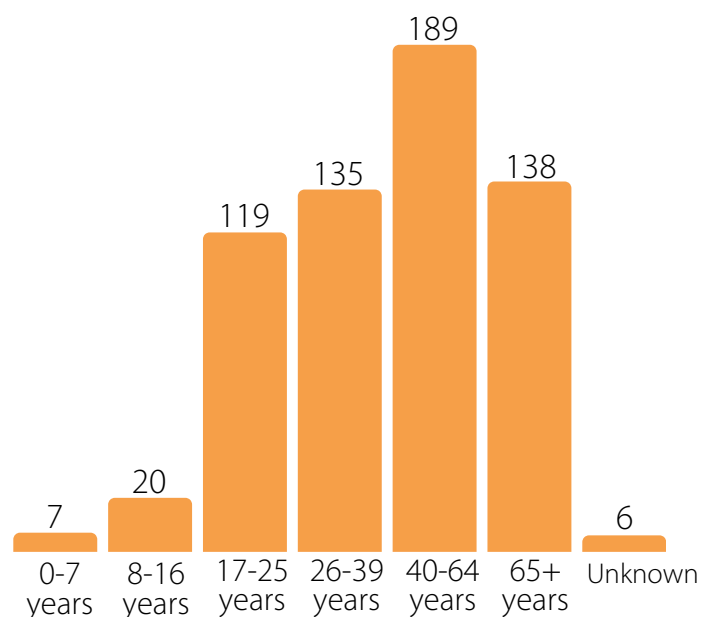
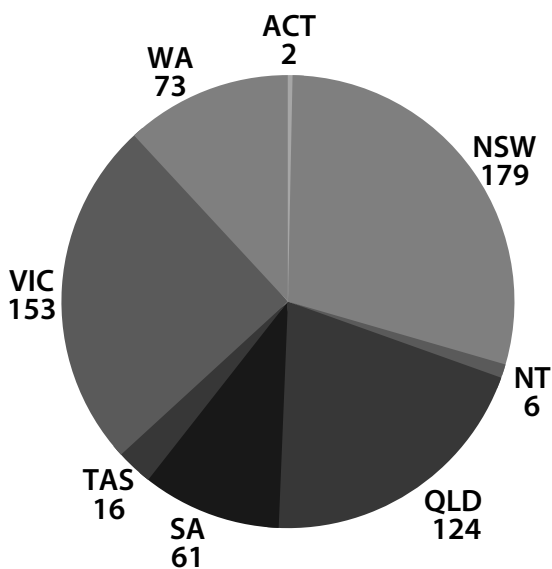
